

Snorkl + Google Trusted Access

In the fall of 2023, Google Workspace made changes to their account authorizations, blocking students from using unconfigured third-party apps.

At Snorkl, we use Google and Microsoft SSO to keep student data safe and secure. To enable students to log in with Google, Google Trusted Access must be enabled. See guidance from Google about how to do so [here](#).



A note on safety:

Student safety and data privacy are very important to us at Snorkl. Our full data and privacy policies are available on our [website](#), but three pieces that are important to note:

- 1. We never sell or publicly disclose student data to outside parties.** Our [subprocessors](#) are utilized only to provide the education services we provide to you and your students and are similarly contractually bound to the privacy of all data collected.
- 2. Our AI tools do not directly receive any student's personally identifiable information.** We strip all PII from a student's response before submitting it for feedback generation and re-attach the feedback generated to the student on our back end.
- 3. We adopt industry best practices to secure student information.** All data is encrypted in transit and at rest, and all users authenticate with Google or Microsoft to ensure an extra layer of sign-in security.
